Checklist for each day:

* Packed lunch and morning tea (more than you usually give them for school days).

We will not heat or refrigerate your child's food

- * Water bottle essential on outings days
- * Suitable clothing & footwear (no jandals, sandals or crocs on outings days please!)
- * Someone to drop off and pick up my child
- * Emergency contact available at short notice
- * Someone to sign your tamariki in or out
- * Rain+coat or warm jacket

Our Fee Structure has changed:

- \$52 fee for 7.30am—5.30pm.
- \$42 fee for 7.30am—3.30pm
- \$42 fee for 8:30am—5.30pm
 \$32 fee for 8:30am—3:30pm

Flat fees include outings so you aren't paying extra!

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Ko wai mātou? Who are we?

The Woolston Development Project is a registered charity which has provided **OSCAR programmes** for over 35 years to our community. We're governed by a board which is made up of people from our local community and managed by Eddie Hayes.

Our **OSCAR programmes** are supervised by our OSCAR supervisors **Marz, Shana, and Rowan, and Penny,** our Whānau Support Worker, and other members of our OSCAR programme team include Amy, Rachel, Rosie, Ava, and Britney.

We also support the community through community development initiatives like our Walking Group, Gentle Yoga, Women's Social Support Group and Te Reo Māori classes. We are working on embedding te ao Māori in our organisation's culture, and one way we do this is by singing karakia before kai times.

Kei hea mātou? Where are we?

We are located at 497 Ferry Road, right across the crossing from Te Waka Unua School. Where this flyer says base, this is what we mean. Sometimes we go for walks to local parks or to the library on days we have no other outings scheduled.

Important

Appropriate clothing

It's winter so please ensure your child has suitable clothing and footwear, and is prepared for changeable weather. No jandals or sandals (including Crocs)

A good sized lunch & morning tea

They get hungrier here. Nothing that needs cooking or chilling please. We sing karakia (no specific religion) before kai each day.

Signing in/out

Children MUST be signed IN and OUT by parents/caregivers unless a consent form has been signed by parents/caregivers allowing staff members to do so. Everyone who picks up your child must be listed as an authorised pickup.

Sick Kids: Please don't send them.

We will contact you to collect them if they become ill during the programme.

If your child has any specific requirements, ensure you specify these on the enrolment form.

Payment of fees: If you qualify for the MSD OSCAR subsidy, they pay us directly and you pay us the difference. **Fees need to be paid in advance** otherwise

Fees can be paid by internet banking to: 03-1599-0022285-000 Woolston Development Project Incorporated, Westpac Bank, Ref: Invoice number.

If you enrol your child and then subsequently do not tell us you have decided not to have your child on the programme after all, let us know ahead of time. If you do not, you may be charged for the time your child was enrolled.

If you drop your child off before 8.30am, we may assume that you want to enrol your child for a 7.30am start that day and invoice you accordingly.

If you are late to collect your child, we may charge late fees. These are calculated at \$10 for the first 10 minutes and \$15 per 5 minutes thereafter.

Text message **022 4894 720** to let us know your child is absent **before 8.45am**. **We charge fees for all absences regardless of the reason.** If your child isn't here by the time we are due to leave on a trip, we may leave without them.

Please don't park in the shared driveway or staff carpark.
